Course Description

Instrumental performance ensembles specializing in literature appropriate to the instruments. (Chamber Wind Ensemble, Flute Choir, Percussion Ensemble, Tuba-Euphonium Ensemble, Horn Choir, Clarinet Ensemble, Saxophone Ensemble, etc.)

Course Level Learning Outcomes

This course provides ensemble experience for clarinet students. In clarinet ensemble:

- Students will be exposed to both original works and transcriptions for clarinet ensemble.
- Students will learn how to play together as a large ensemble, working on techniques like intonation, articulation style, balance, etc.
- Students will observe clarinet ensemble rehearsals as members, providing an example for forming their own clarinet ensembles as music educators and professional musicians.

Course Outline

Students will rehearse once a week for 50 minutes. Throughout the semester, the ensemble will perform on recitals both on and off campus, depending on the semester.

Required Materials

Students will be provided with music for this ensemble.

Course Assessments

Students will be assessed by their performance in the ensemble, attendance, preparation for rehearsal, and professionalism. Students may be given pop quizzes to ensure rehearsal preparation.
