 - A. Course Description:**
 1. Private applied music instruction in flute.
 - B. Course Level Learning Objectives:**
 1. Students will be expected to come to each lesson prepared to play materials assigned in the previous lesson.
 2. Specific learning outcomes are as follows:
 - a) At the end of this course, students shall demonstrate mastery of the fundamentals of playing the flute. These fundamentals include:
 - (1) Scales
 - (2) Intonation
 - (3) Rhythm
 - (4) Dynamics and musical expression

Scales – major, minor, chromatic
Arpeggios – major, minor
Tone development
Etudes
Repertoire selected from standard flute literature spanning the Baroque era through the 21st Century
